I met bassplayer Fran and drummer
David one early Autumn night,
at the Redfern house shared by
Fran and Cannane's guitarist
Steven.As they explained to me
over drinks on the back balcony,
they think most bands take things a
bit too far.

FRAN:"I think people take this whole business overbaord, practising day in and day out the same songs, and spending six months working out this one song."

DAVID:"...People take themselves so seriously.We almost feel that we should make it into a bit of a joke cos everyone else is so pompous."

The Cannanes were a concept of being a band before they were even a band!

They got together around late '84

when David Nichols and then-time

vocalist Annabel Bleach moved into a house in Chippendale in which the front room was used as a gear storage/rehearsal room by the Lighthouse Keepers. As it happened, Stephen O'Neil, who was the light house Keepers' guitarist at the time, lived across the road. Stephen had formed his own project, a Barry White covers band called The Newtown Sounds with Fran Gibson. As Annabel and David wrote lyrics, and Fran and Stephen had instruments, they put them together and got the Cannanes! The concept was consolidated with the inclusion of percussionist Michelle Cannane, who (obviously) gave her name to the project. FRAN: "Sounds like a joke to me now when anyone claims to be called the Cannanes. Like Michelle's parents-

In late 1985 Angelo Tsakos, a sixteen year old unemployed ethnic youth from the western suburbs, was shot dead by Police Constable Michael Harris near Angelo's home-suburb of Blacktown. At the time Angelo was in a car, a Ford Laser, seated behind the wheel. The policeman stopped the car on the (correct) suspician that it was stolen.

What happened next is not clear. At the Coroner's Inquiry into the incident, The policeman claimed that he was behind the car at the time of the shooting, and fired the gun in self-defence as Angelo began to reverse the vehicle with the intention of running him over. However, this story was contradicted by evidence given by an independent witness, a truck driver, who was parked behind the Jaser less than five metres away and saw the whole thing happen. The truck driver said that Nichael Harris was never behind the car. He ran to the side, crouched and shot Angelo from a distance of two-and-a-half feet.

Not surprisingly, the policeman changed his story by the time the case came to trial in August, 1986. This time, he claimed the gun went off accidentally.

Harris was charged with manslaughter, which means that although he fired the gun with the intention to wound Angelo, he did not mean to kill. Considering the truck-driver's testimony, and the annormalities in the policeman's evidence, a clear verdict of guilty would seem apparent. Not according to the jury. Warris was acquitted of manslaughter and set free, leaving behind a dead youth, a broken-hearted family, and a group of very angry people in Blacktown.

According to William Beattie, the solicitor now assisting the Tsakos family in their pursuit of justice, a lot of responsibility for the outcome lies with the judge. "The Judge virtually steered the jury to that decision of acquittal in his summing up", says Beattie. "The Judge biased the case."

Note that the Tsakos family were in court to protest about the decision. None of the family, nor their solicitor, was informed when the case was finally heard. They did not findout about the trial, nor the verdict, until a month later, by which time it was too late to appeal appeal has to be lodged within 21 days of the close of the trial.) The family

TALL TALES AND TRUE-A Tale To Tell Tall Tales And True have been around for some four years now, and in that time have established themselves as a solid three-piece working unit, gaining favourable response both locally and interstate. The band recently supported the Triffids on their hometown return, playing gigs in Melbourne, Sydney and Brisbane. R.F. Puddle and the Murderess talked to singer/guitarist Matthew De la Hunty and bassist Paul Miskin, just after their Brisbane tour supporting the Triffids. Matthew's wife Jane was also present, providing cups of coffee, doughnuts, and odd bits of information. Drummer Dave Rashleigh was not.

BLUNT: Is this the first band you've all played in?

PAUL: "It's the first band Dave and myself have been in. We both basical ly left high school and joined this band. There were a few "muck around" bands at school, one called The Green Onions Jug Band which we might put out on a bootleg cassette one day if TT&T become famous."

MATTHEW: "I originate from Perth from a suburb on the south side of the Swan River. Over there I essentially had just one band called The Nobodys which I formed with Martyn Casey, the Triffids bassist. That was some seven years ago, we lasted for about 18 months."
